### DCWS Nightnotes Series Presents *Double the Reeds, Double the Fun* with Sally Pituch

Southfield, MI – January XX, 2011 – On February 4, 2011, Nightnotes Artistic Director Sally Pituch will demonstrate her English horn virtuosity at *Double the Reeds, Double the Fun*. DCWS' Nightnotes series takes place in the intimate atmosphere of Hagopian World of Rugs in Birmingham. A reception begins at 8PM with the music starting at 8:30 PM. “As Artistic Director of Nightnotes, I am excited to showcase this wonderful instrument,” says Pituch. “The English horn is a lot like an oboe, only it is longer and the sound is much lower.”

Pituch plays English horn and oboe with the Michigan Opera Theatre Orchestra and Detroit Chamber Winds & Strings. She will be joined by Karl Pituch, principal horn of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, and pianist Mary Beth Orr, who teaches horn at Alma College and plays with the Lansing Symphony, Traverse Symphony, and Midland Symphony.

The concert will begin with Émile Paladilhe's Concertante for oboe and piano and continue with the Sonata for solo horn by Vitaly Bujanovsky. Following this, Alyssa Morris' *Four Personalities* will offer a musical interpretation of the Hartman Personality Test. The Hartman Test divides personalities into four colors, each having distinct traits. Following intermission, the concert will conclude with Heinrich von Herzogenberg's Trio in D major, Op. 61.
